The focus on prevention, rapid rehousing, and ensuring that experiences of homelessness are not recurring resonates with the objectives outlined in various UK government initiatives and local authority strategies aimed at tackling homelessness. For instance, the emphasis on prevention reflects the priority placed on early intervention and prevention programs by local councils and government bodies such as the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government (MHCLG). The aim to make experiences of homelessness brief and non-recurring echoes the objectives outlined in national strategies like "Everybody In" and "Ending Rough Sleeping: A Housing First Approach," which seek to address not only the immediate housing needs but also the underlying factors contributing to homelessness, such as mental health issues, substance abuse, and lack of affordable housing.

Healthwatch Birmingham feel that there is not enough detail about supportive health schemes for those at risk of homelessness, or those homeless due to health related issues. Whilst priority 3 outlines a joined up approach with other services, we feel there is scope for the council to include a leadership role in the values and principles, ensuring people receive a joined up approach from services they need, especially with regards to health.

Whilst we agree with the state priorities, we feel there are a few potential gaps:

- Health and Social care Services: Many individuals experiencing homelessness face complex health issues, including mental health challenges and substance abuse disorders. Integrating and leading co-ordination of healthcare services, mental health services, and substance abuse services is a key area to address.
- Affordable Housing: While prevention and support services are crucial, addressing the root causes of homelessness, such as the lack of affordable housing, is key.
- Employment and Income Support: Economic instability and unemployment can contribute significantly to homelessness. Integrating strategies to support employment opportunities, vocational training, and access to stable income sources for individuals experiencing homelessness could enhance the effectiveness of the overall approach.
- Long-Term Support: Ensuring that individuals exiting homelessness have access to ongoing support services and resources to maintain housing stability is crucial. Including a focus on long-term support and follow-up care could help prevent recurrences of homelessness as per the stated aim.
